## Summer Reading Activities

- 1. Read for 20 minutes.
- 2. Do the weekly "take away" project from the library. You can pick these activity packets up at the library beginning on Monday of each week at 10am. They will be available inside the library Monday through Friday 10am - 5pm and Saturday 9am - 12pm as long as supplies last.
- 3. Read a tale or story about an animal. (Limit 1)
- 4. Write a short folktale that explains how an animal got a trait that it is known for. For example, write a story that explains how the frog learned to hopped. (Limit 1)
- 5. Have you ever heard of the blobfish? Learn more about the blob fish by checking out this website <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=FoM9GauYhc0</u> or Google blob fish
- 6. Color the fuzzy fish poster in your folder (Limit 1)
- 7. Unplug for one full day. Don't watch TV, use video or electronic games, or any computer device. (Only use cellphones to make phone calls no texting.) (Limit 2)
- 8. Download an audio book, ebook, or movie from the library's webpage www.montmorencylibrary.com - search e-books in our online catalog (Limit 2)
- 9. Check out a dvd that has an animal theme. (Limit 1)
- 10. Take your dog, a neighbor's dog or a friend's dog for a walk. (Limit 1)
- 11. Plant some flowers or vegetable seeds. (Limit 1)
- 12. Post a picture of one of your completed projects on the Tails & Tales thread of the library facebook page. Find it at Montmorency co pub libraries on facebook (Limit 2)
- 13. Research an animal that you don't know much about. Draw a detailed picture and write on the name of the animal, where it lives and at least one interesting fact about it! (Limit 1) There's more on the back-
