The Summer Reading program will be “take away” this year. Every weekly project will be made into packets that will be available for pick up inside the library Monday through Friday from 10 am until 5pm & Saturday 9 am – 12 pm, of each week, until they are gone. The first week you will also pick up a program folder with all the information. Parents and guardians will be responsible for signing activity logs. When the log is completed and turned back in to the library you will earn a special program t-shirt that will be ordered especially for you. There will be no end of the program party this year. However, there will be many special activities along the way. The program begins June 14th but you can join anytime, as long as folders are available. It is a 6 week program for all children ages 3 – 16 years old. (Please let us know if you have an older or special needs friend that would like to participate. We would love to include them.) Participants will have 6 weeks to do fun reading, learning and civic activities to complete their log. For each accomplishment a parent or guardian will sign or mark your log.

The program starts June 14th. Be sure to stop in at your local Montmorency County Public Libraries branch, and pick up your program packet. We encourage participants to take pictures of their projects and share them on the library facebook page thread. Look for it on facebook at Montmorency co pub libraries.
