

Montmorency County Public Libraries announce...



The Summer Reading program will be similar to last year with weekly project / activity kits. This year there will also be some inside the library activities. Weekly projects will be made into packets that will be available for pick up inside the library Monday through Friday from 10 am until 5pm & Saturday 9 am – 12 pm, of each week, until they are gone. The first week you will also pick up a program folder with all the information. When the log is completed and turned back in to the library you will earn a special program t-shirt that will be ordered especially for you. The program begins June 13th. You can choose to drop in and participate when you can, without completing and turning in the log at the end. (This is a great option for Grandparents who have kids visiting for just a week or two.) Do what works for your family. The program will run for 6 weeks and is targeted to children ages 3 – 16 years old. (Please let us know if you have an older or special needs friend that would like to participate. We would love to include them.) Participants will have 6 weeks to do fun reading, learning and civic activities to complete their log. For each accomplishment a parent or guardian will sign or mark the log.

The program starts June 13th. Be sure to stop in at your local Montmorency County Public Libraries branch, and pick up your program packet.
